

CAHAN Alert

Alert Message

Per CDC's press release issued January 5th, 2015, the country of Mali will be removed from the list of Ebola-affected nations as of Tuesday, January 6th. Travelers from Mali are no longer required to enter at designated airports, or undergo enhanced screening and monitoring. The Alert Level 2 Travel notice for Mali, which advised travelers to practice enhanced precautions while in the country, will also be removed. Travelers departing Mali still require outbound screening, and travelers returning from Mali before January 6th will still require active monitoring and symptom reporting for twenty-one days following their departure. Level 3 travel warnings remain in place for Guinea, Liberia, and Sierra Leone.
