Providers are required to meet the following requirements during the 90-day reporting period in order to be eligible to attest to meaningful use.

Patient Records in Certified EHR Technology

At least 80% of the patients must have records in the certified EHR technology

Numerator Denominator Percentage

Numerator = number of patients with records in the certified EHR technology during this reporting period

Denominator = total number of patients during this reporting period

Numerator: Total number of patients with records in your certified EHR during the MU Reporting Period.

Denominator: Total number of patients during the MU Reporting Period.

Location Information

At least 50% of your patient encounters during the reporting period must have occurred at a practice location with certified EHR technology. In addition to the practice locations you specified for program eligibility in Step 2 (which are displayed in the table below) you are required to add all locations at which you practiced during the meaningful use reporting period. For each location you must specify the number of patient encounters and whether certified EHR technology was used at that location during the reporting period.

You must add all locations where you practice and designate the percentage of patient’s records in certified EHR technology at each location.

Numerator = Number of patient encounters in the denominator at the specified location during this reporting period.

Percentage of total patient encounters at locations where certified EHR technology is available: **0.00 %**

50% Encounters with CEHRT

To be considered a meaningful EHR user, at least 50 percent of an EP's patient encounters, during the EHR reporting period, must occur at a practice/location or practices/locations equipped with certified EHR technology.

Meaningful Use for EPs Working in Multiple Settings

- An Eligible Professional who works at multiple locations, but does not have certified EHR technology available at all of them would:
 - Have to have 50% of their total patient encounters at locations where certified EHR technology is available
 - Would base all meaningful use measures only on encounters that occurred at locations where certified EHR technology is available

Multiple Sites Data Requests

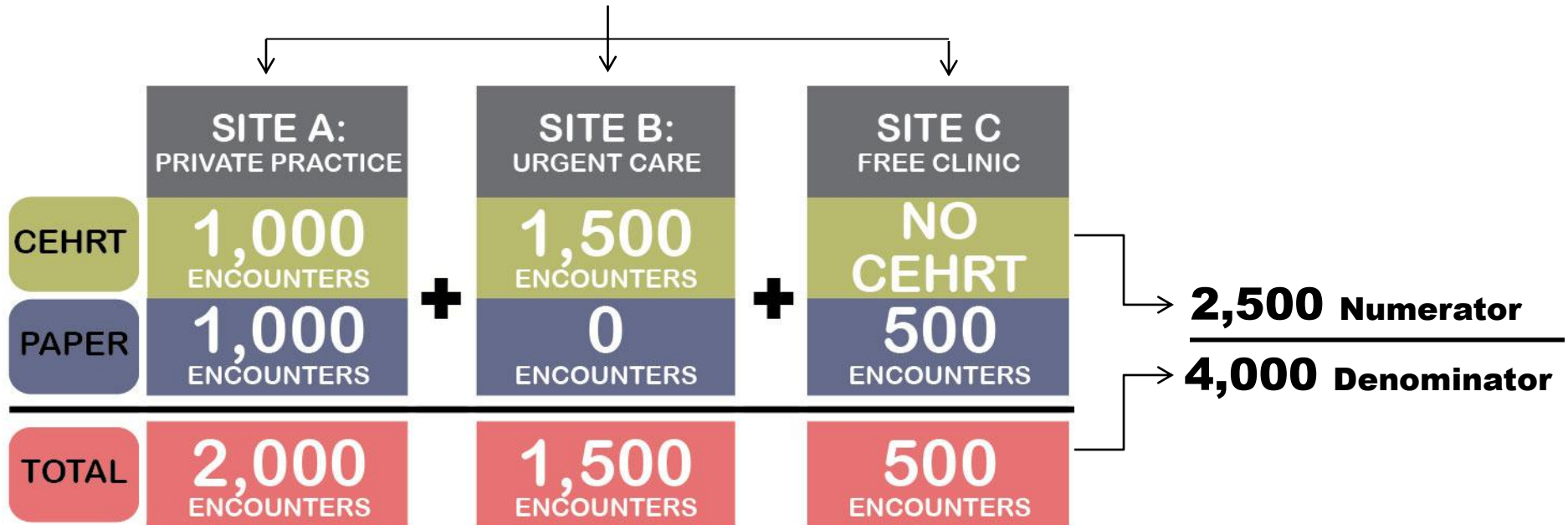
Q: What if EP's other organization is not responding to requests for data?"

A: There is no exclusion for not including data from all locations where an EP used CEHRT during the reporting period.


During the EHR reporting period, does the eligible professional have **50%** or more of all of their **PATIENT ENCOUNTERS** at a practice location or locations equipped with a CEHRT?

Why?

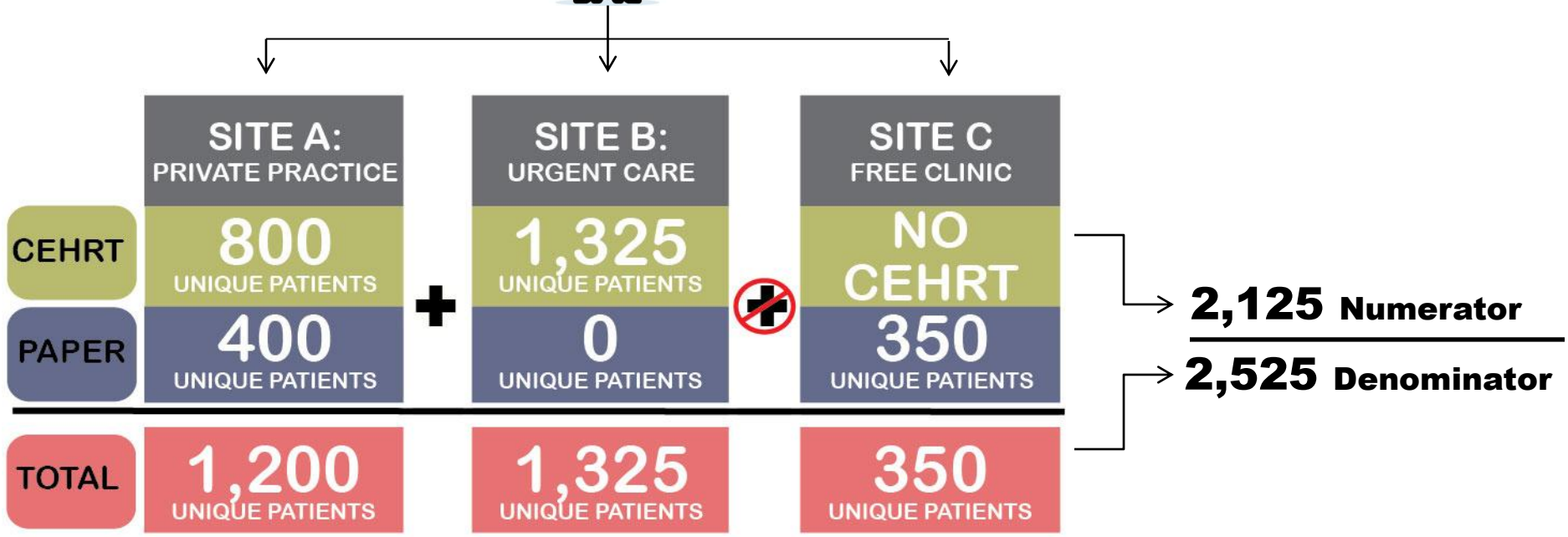
MU Objective: Problem list

- More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP have at least one entry or an indication that no problems are known for the patient recorded as structured data

Do at least **80%** of all **UNIQUE PATIENTS** seen during the reporting period have records maintained in the CEHRT? *(The denominator is only those unique patients seen at locations where CEHRT is available.)*
